



Matrix Wildfire Launches First-Ever Online Surplus Auction on GovDeals

Its high-output system can project a fine aerosolized water spray across large areas, making it suitable for applications ranging from petrochemical fires and refinery incidents to hazardous vapor suppression and critical infrastructure protection.
